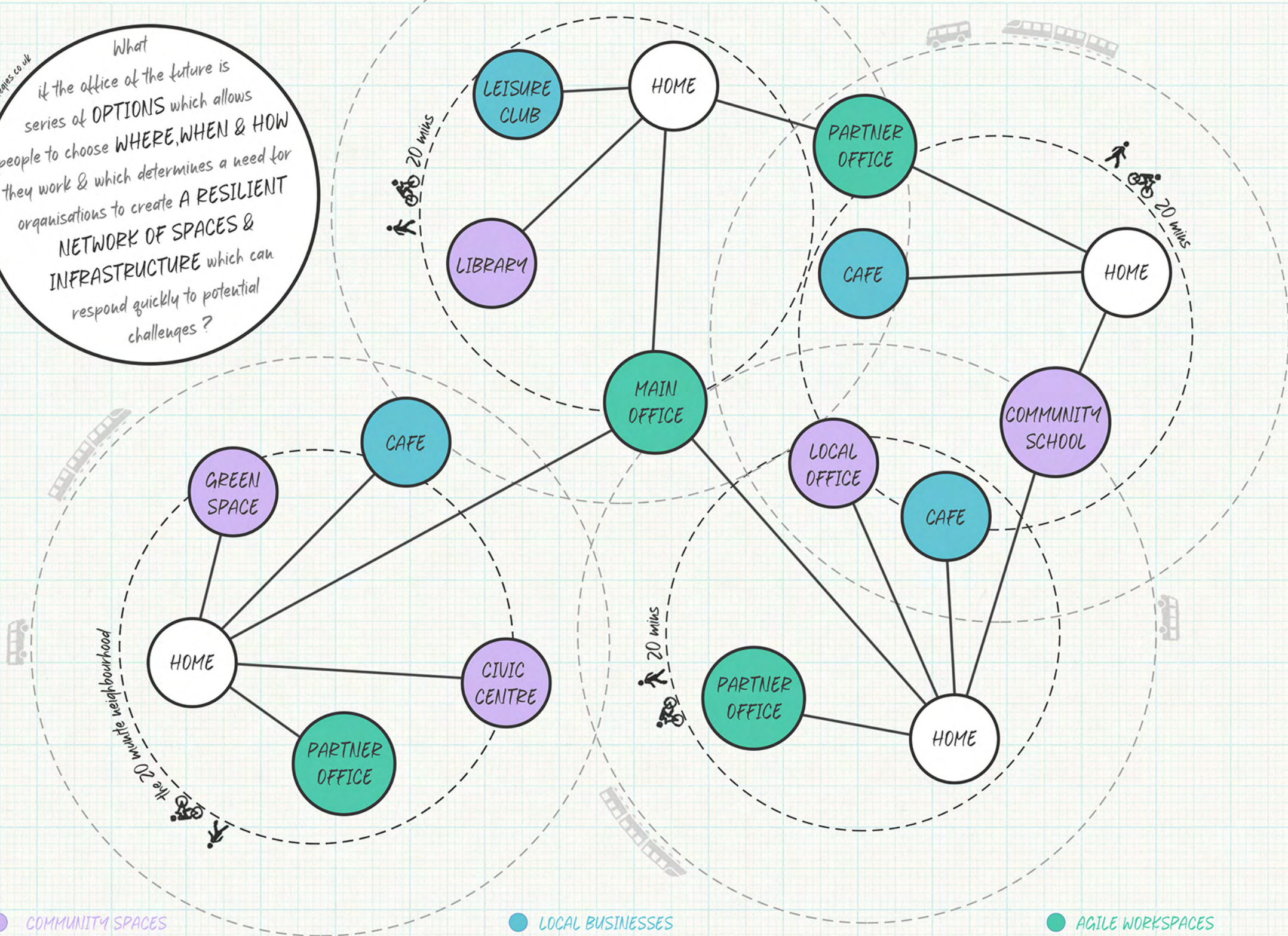

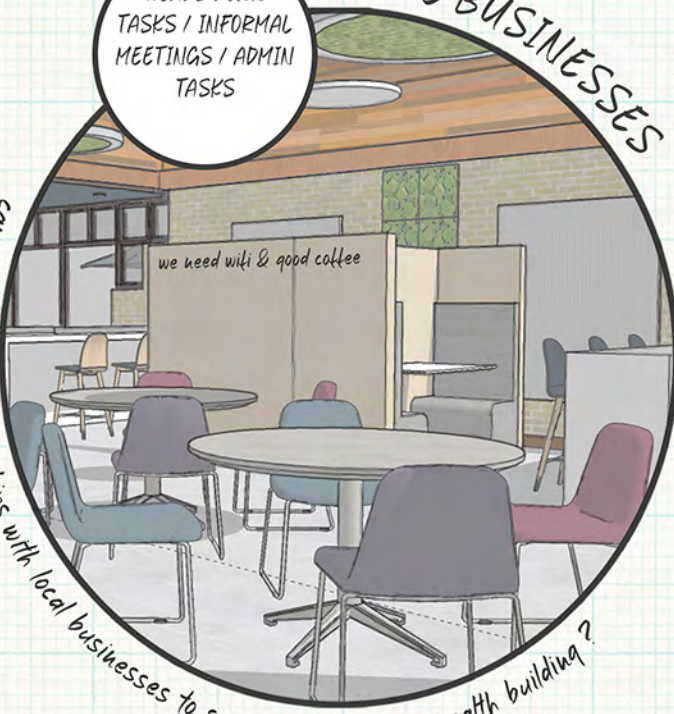

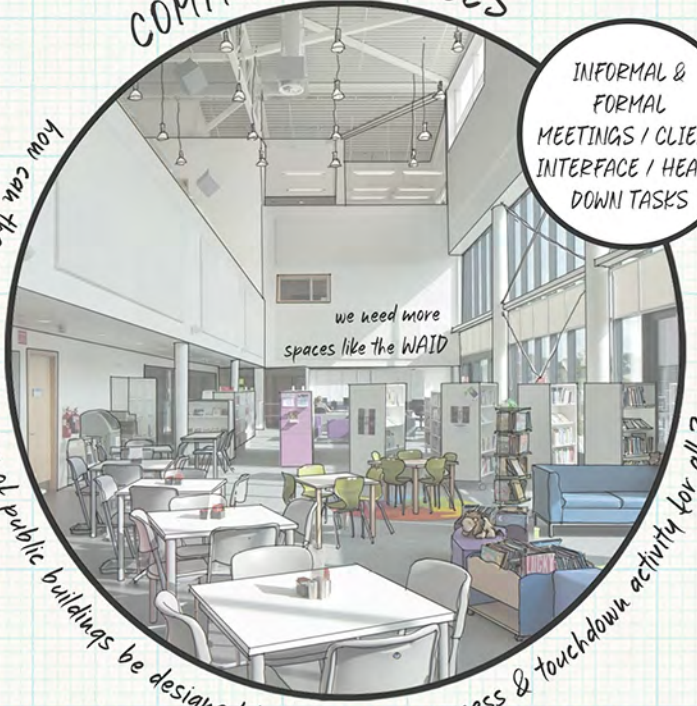
should staff get an allowance for setting up their home office?

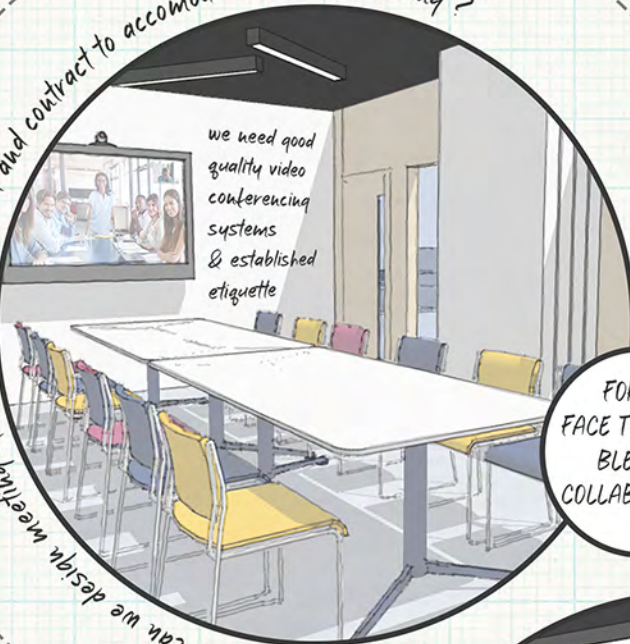

can materials / upholstery with antibacterial properties be specified?

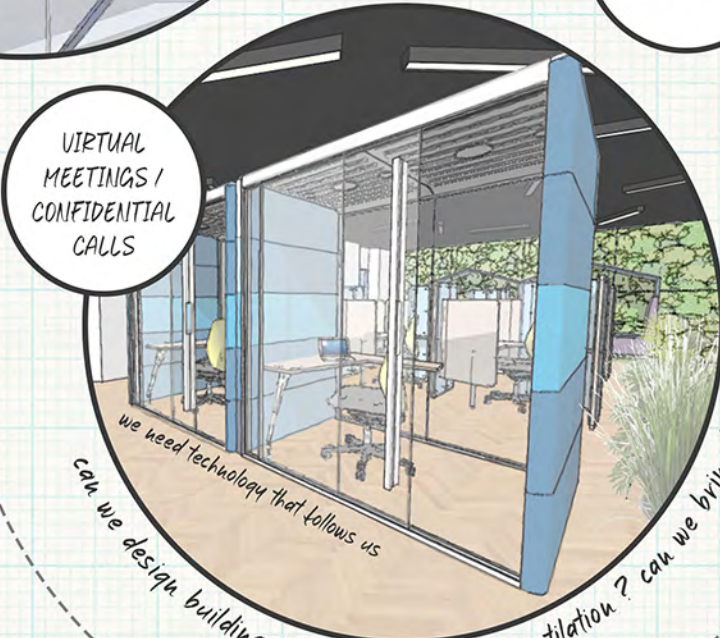

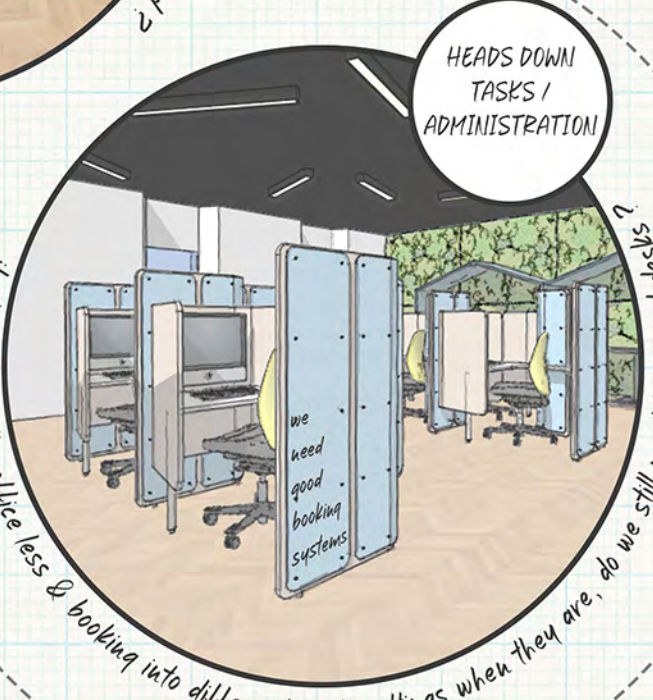
